AccessPatrol

This is a mechanism of monitoring and reporting on how files are moved from client machines via removable media, thus indicating where and how employees are removing and/or deleting critical files from their machines using USB devices be those keys or mobile phones or by creating CD/DVDs. This specifically addresses this area of security relating to employee data theft or misappropriation.

In addition to restricting Internet activity, the latest version now includes an Application Blocker, which allows you to specify software applications you want to block the user from running. This can be useful in preventing users from using games, messaging programs, P2P applications or any unauthorized software.
